Siddiq Fadzil in his paper entitled "Raja Ali Haji: His Scholarly and Authorship" talks about the various roles of Raja Ali Haji who is not only a scientist, culturalist, administrator, but also as a guide

to the king and an educator of the people. Ahmad Zaki Abdul Latiff and Fairuzah Basri presented a paper entitled "Aspects of Sufism in the Works of Raja Ali Haji". This paper tries to show about the role of Raja Ali Haji who is considered to be a writer with a Sufi spirit. In Khalif Muammar A. Harris's paper entitled "Islamic Judicial System in the Works of Raja Ali Haji", he touched on Thamarat al-Muhimmah which is a continuation of a short treatise entitled Muqaddimah fi Intizam Waza'if al-Malik. Wazzainab Ismail and Hafida Mohamed Nordin in the paper titled "Returning the Excellence of Scholars is a Challenge for the People through the Perspective of Raja Ali Haji" discussed the works and examples of Raja Ali Haji's personality as an effort to restore the excellence of scholars in the Malay region.

Arba'iyah Mohd Noor presented his paper titled "Historical Thoughts of King Ali Haji Through Tuhfat Al-Nafis, Masterpiece of the Sultanate of Johor-Riau-Lingga". The background and historical thoughts of Raja Ali Haji are examined with reference to his famous historical work Tuhfat Al-Nafis as well as Raja Ali Haji's letters to Von de Wall. Ayu Nor Azilah Mohamad's paper titled "The Role of Raja Ali Haji in Religious and Political Clashes in the Malay World" talks about the religious and political clashes that occur in this region and the role of Raja Ali Haji in dealing with it. The paper titled "Thoughts of Raja Ali Haji through Poems" by Abu Hassan Sham tries to highlight some of Raja Ali Haji's

poems which are considered to have their own special features. Tatiana A. Denisova's paper titled "19th Century Malay Statecraft through the View of Raja Ali Haji: A Study Based on the Historical Works of Tuhfat Al-Nafis" discusses not only some historical concepts, but also contains elements of Islamic statecraft and didacticism. Norfazil Ab. Hamid, Rohaini Amin and Zurina Abdullah presented a paper entitled "The Malay Language as a Vessel of Dakwah and Education through the Eyes of Raja Ali Haji". In general, the Malay language is seen as capable of being a tool in the delivery of preaching and education to the community. The conclusion is that all researchers have tried to interpret, deepen and express the thoughts of Raja Ali Haji in various aspects whether from the point of view of religion, politics, history, language and so on.
